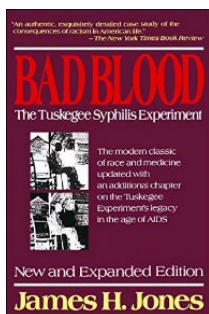

**Bad Blood**  
**The Tuskegee Syphilis Experiment**

*In this revised edition (1993) of **Bad Blood**, the author follows the tragic consequences of the Tuskegee study including the widespread distrust of public health officials within the black community hampering efforts to combat AIDS. The 40-year study conducted by the US Public Health involved over four hundred black men infected with syphilis. The author concludes that the Tuskegee study is not an aberration but an outgrowth of race relations in the USA. The book was nominated for the prestigious Pulitzer Prize and was on the "N.Y. Times" 12 best books of the year.*
